Dave Oakes Seminars

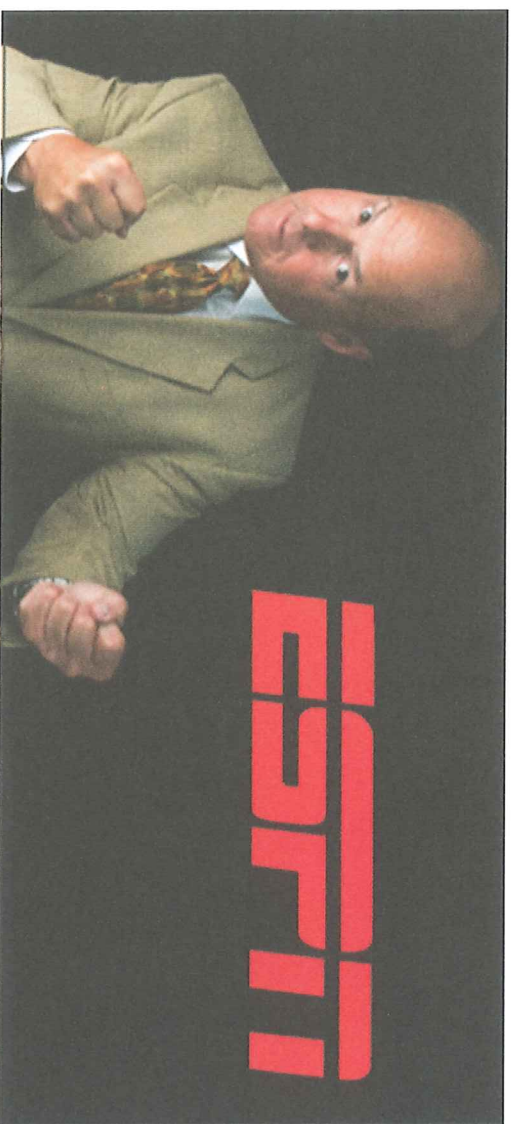
